Figure 4a is the original image. Figure 4b is the magnitude of the Fourier transform, scaled as log(magnitude) for display purposes. Figure 4c is the phase of the Fourier transform.



Both the magnitude and the phase are needed for faithful reproduction of the original image.



Figure 5a shows image restoration based only on the magnitude. It is a miserable failure. Figure 5b shows image restoration based only on the phase. It is recognizable, but lacks magnitude to display contrast and a complete complement, from pure white to darkest black.
