## MATH 1010-2: INTERMEDIATE ALGEBRA Addendum to the Grading Policy

Effective September 7, 2010, the following addendum to the grading policy will be enforced. Each time a student disrupts class, a percentage will subtracted from their final grade according to the following schedule:

First disruption: $2 \%$ will be subtracted from the final grade.
Second disruption: An additional $4 \%$ will be subtracted.
Third disruption: An additional $8 \%$ will be subtracted.
Fourth disruption: An additional $16 \%$ will be subtracted.
Fifth disruption: Student will automatically fail the class.
Examples of disruptions include: texting during class, talking during class (except when addressing me with a question), having a cell phone ring or vibrate during class, arriving late in a disruptive fashion, and packing up and leaving early in a disruptive fashion. (This list is not complete.)
