

## Math 1010-90 Course Materials

**ALEKS:** Online homework and practice material. Using ALEKS is required.

**Textbook:** *Intermediate Algebra*, 5th Edition by Julie Miller, Molly O'Neill, Nancy Hyde. The textbook provides written explanations and practice material. Using the textbook is optional. An E-book version of the textbook comes bundled with ALEKS.

**Bundled Cost: \$78.20**

(It is not possible to purchase just ALEKS for a lower cost.)

Access to ALEKS and the textbook will be provided with the Inclusive Access Program. With Inclusive Access, the fees for course materials are added to each student's tuition bill. By doing this, prices are kept lower and access to materials is simpler. All you will need to do is click a link in Canvas. This is how the Inclusive Access Program works:

- An email will go out to all Math1010-90 students prior to the first day of class with information on what Inclusive Access is and instructions on how to access their digital course materials.
- Students have the option to OPT OUT, but the default is to opt in. If a student opts out during the first two weeks of class, they will not be charged for ALEKS, but they will be responsible for purchasing access from publisher, which is more expensive.
- A student may print a certain number of pages from the e-book. If a student wishes to order a hard copy of the book, they can talk to Heidi Booth (U of U Bookstore) and discuss options.
- We will have a copy of the hardback version of the textbook at the UofU Math Tutoring Center (when it reopens) and at the Reserve Desk in the Marriott Library. You can check these out for a few hours.
