ALEKS: Online homework and practice material. Using ALEKS is required.

Textbook: Intermediate Algebra, 6th Edition by Julie Miller, Molly O'Neill, Nancy Hyde. The textbook provides written explanations and practice material. Using the textbook is optional. An E-book version of the textbook comes bundled with ALEKS.

Bundled Cost: about \$86 (It is not possible to purchase just ALEKS for a lower cost.)

Access to ALEKS and the textbook will be provided with the Inclusive Access Program. With Inclusive Access, the fees for course materials are added to each student's tuition bill. By doing this, prices are kept lower and access to materials is simpler. All you will need to do is click a link in Canvas. This is how the Inclusive Access Program works:

- Students have the option to OPT OUT (see email sent to you from the Bookstore before the semester starts or when you join the class), but we recommend not doing this. If you opt out, you are not able to do the required online HW in ALEKS. The only way to reinstate access is to purchase this separately, which costs much times more than going through inclusive access. If you need to do this, contact the UofU Bookstore.
- If you would like to occasionally use a physical book (this would be in addition to inclusive access), there are a couple copies of the book at the Reserve Desk in the Marriott Library that can be check out for a few hours at a time.
- If you would like to order a hard copy of the book, contact Heidi Booth (<u>hbooth@campusstore.utah.edu</u>) at the U of U Bookstore and discuss options.
