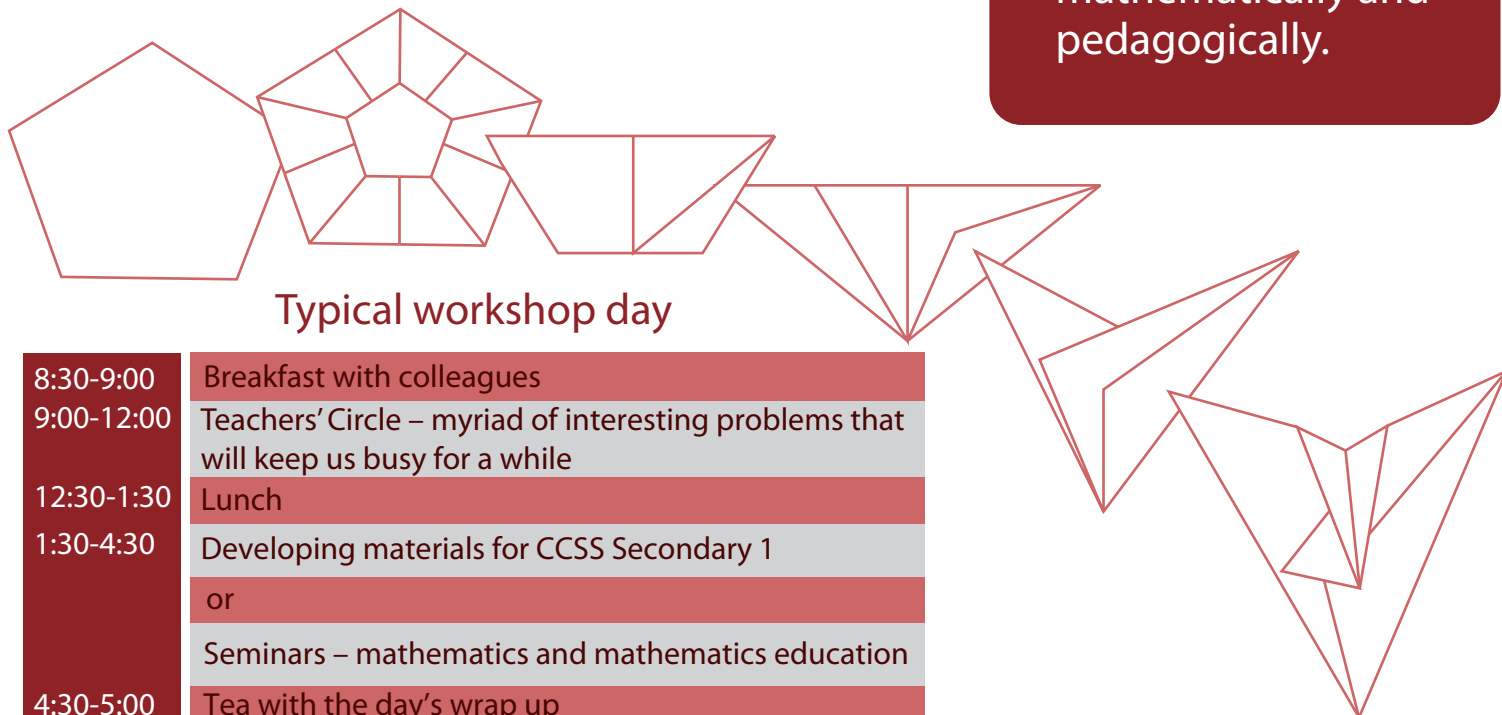


# Summer workshop for teachers
