Remember that you are required to write a paper clearly describing your project: background, model(s), methods of analysis, and results. The paper is to be turned in by April 24.

On April 24, each person or group will give a short presentation to the class about his/her or their project. Please prepare a presentation of about 8 minutes in length (practice it so you know how long it is) that introduces the problem you worked on, describes the basic model you developed, and gives some of your results. When preparing the presentation (and paper) keep asking yourself whether it will be understandable to someone who hasn't been looking at the problem for several weeks like you have. You may use the chalkboard to do your presentation, but, if so, remember how long it takes to write things on the board. Alternatively, you may use transparencies and the overhead projector, or you may use your laptop. I'll bring a portable projector to use with the laptop.
