

MIDTERM #2 CORRECTIONS – MATH 3210

You may submit corrections to problems you got wrong on the midterms. You can earn up to 50% of the missed points back added to your exam score.

This is due on Monday, December 3rd, in class. You must staple or otherwise attach the corrections to the *back* of your original exam.

Some rules and comments.

- You must submit a complete correct answer to a missed problem to receive credit. In particular, for problems, 2, 3, 4 and EC, you need to write up complete new solutions. For problem #1, you must only write up the problems ((a), (b), (c), etc.) you lost points out.
- You must write up your solution *very* clearly and neatly (typing it will guarantee it is neatly written) in order to receive credit.
- If you lost an odd number of points then half points can be earned back.
- I will grade the corrections more harshly than I graded the original exam (since there is no time pressure).
- You can receive partial credit back on the extra credit problem.
